RHE

For Summer 2, RHE being will focus upon 'Safe and Unsafe Situations'. In Year 1, this will entail learning about keeping ourselves safe and who can help to keep us safe.

RE

Our focus for RE will be... What it means to belong to a faith community. For Summer 2, our exciting 'Moon Zoom' topic continues.

This topic has a strong focus on Geography and History. We have been learning about human and physical features of the Earth. In Summer 2, we are going to learn about the life of Neil Armstrong.

In PE, Mr O'Brien will be focusing on skills needed for games. These will include; throwing and catching, attacking and defending and spatial awareness.

Our PE day in Year 1 will remain a Friday afternoon. Please can children bring their PE kit into school in a bag and leave it on their peg until the end of the term.



Maths

In maths we have worked extremely hard in Year 1!

In Summer 2, we will work on place value up to 100.

We will also be looking at position and direction.



Science

Our final science topic this year is 'Seasonal Change'

During this topic we will be looking at changes in weather across the year and how day length varies.



Literacy & Phonics

This half term we will be retelling the story of 'Beegu' - a lovely story about an alien who crash lands on Earth.

In phonics we will be continuing to work through our Sounds-Write units. This will include looking at different spellings for the sounds: /l/, /s/, /u/ and n/or/.
