Literacy & Phonics

In maths we have worked extremely hard in Year 2!

We will be revisiting some of the areas that have been taught. These will include; the four operations (+, -, x, ÷) as well as fractions, measurement and time. Our final science topic this year is 'Animals including humans.'

During this topic we will be looking at life cycles, basic needs of animals (including humans) and a healthy diet.

This half term we will be writing instructions (for a recipe), a story based on George's Marvellous Medicine and a descriptive poem about food.

In phonics we will be continuing to work through our Sounds-Write units. This will include looking at different spellings for the sounds: /h/, /k/, /r/, /t/, /z/&/eer/.
